

23. Non-Smoking Policy

Statement of intent

We comply with health and safety regulations and the Safeguarding and Welfare Requirements of the EYFS in making our setting a no-smoking environment – both indoor and outdoor.

Aim

To maintain our setting as a smoke-free zone – both indoors and outdoors

- All staff, parents/carers and volunteers are made aware of our no-smoking policy.
- We display no-smoking signs.
- The no-smoking policy is stated in our information for parents/carers.
- We actively encourage no-smoking by having information for parents/carers and staff about where to get help to stop smoking if they are seeking this information.
- Staff who smoke do not do so during working hours, unless on a break and off the premises.
- Staff who smoke during their break make every effort to reduce the effect of the odour and lingering effects of passive smoking for children and colleagues.
